Decision of Louth County Council under Article 5(1) of the Waste Management (Permit) Regulations 1998 (SI No 165 of 1998)

Waste Permit Register No WP 2008/06

In pursuance of the powers conferred on it by the Waste Management Acts 1996 – 2008 and the Waste Management (Permit) Regulations 1998 (SI No 165 of 1998), Louth County Council grants this waste permit under Article 5(1) of the said Regulations to **Lenviron Ltd T/A Leinster Environmentals, 16 Francis Street, Dundalk, Co Louth** to carry on at premises at Clermont Business Park, Haggardstown, Dundalk the waste activities listed below, subject to ten conditions, with the reasons therefore and the schedules attached thereto set out in the permit.

Permitted Activities, in accordance with the First Schedule of the Waste Management (Permit) Regulations 1998 (SI No 165 of 1998):

Activity 5: The recovery of waste (other than hazardous waste) at a facility (other than a facility for the composting of waste where the amount of compost and waste held at the facility exceeds 1000 cubic metres at any time).

These activities are limited to the permitted three classes of waste recovery activity, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts 1996 - 2007, as listed and limited below.

Permitted Waste Recovery Activities, in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the Waste Management Acts 1996 - 2008:

Class 2 (Principal Activity) Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents including composting and other biological transformation processes.

This activity is limited to the recovery of organic wastes, including paper, cardboard, plastic and wood, at the facility.

Class 4 Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.

This activity is limited to the collection of other inorganic wastes, including glass, at the facility for recovery.

Class 13 Storage of waste intended for the submission to any activity referred to in a preceding paragraph of this Schedule, other than temporary storage, pending collection, on the premises where such waste is produced.

This activity is limited to the storage of wastes at the facility prior to recovery.
